Snow Removal



Snow removal includes Shoveling of sidewalks, steps, stoops, plowing of the parking lots and Salting of all surfaces. The snow contractor lives on site, so you will be seeing them walk around inspecting all areas. Pre-storm & post-storm touch-ups will be as needed. You will notice the use of an ATV, leaf blowers, skid steer, & a truck with and front & back plows.

Neighbor Wellness Check: Don't forget to keep an eye out for your neighbors during the very cold & snowy winter days. Not everyone has family to check in on them. If you think someone needs help, you can call the police and ask for a "Wellbeing Check" at their address.

Don't leave your car running & unlocked.

It's **illegal** in **Illinois** to **leave your vehicle running, unlocked & unattended**. You could get a ticket. The only exception, according to Waukegan police officers, are if you have a keyless remote start or ignition safety switch like they have in their squad **cars**; it allows you to pop the keys out and render the **vehicle** locked while it is **running**.
